

COVID-19 Statement – Air-Tite Products

Update April 1, 2020

Air-Tite Products continues to closely monitor the spread and impact of the COVID-19 coronavirus.

As a globally-sourced importer of hypodermic supplies, we are acutely aware of the impact that the spread of this virus is having on supply streams around the world. All of our supply and manufacturing partners have felt some effect due to the virus – including logistics delays, constrained upstream supply chains, and increased downstream demand for certain products. Below are the steps that Air-Tite is taking to protect our employees, our supply chains, and our customers:

<u>Our Employees</u> – Air-Tite Products is monitoring and implementing current WHO and CDC recommendations. Employees who may be at higher risk are being encouraged to work remotely, and all employees have been instructed to:

- wash hands frequently
- practice physical distancing
- use disinfectant wipes on frequently touched surfaces
- use company-provided PPE (e.g. masks and gloves) in the office
- stay home if they feel unwell or become symptomatic
- postpone or cancel travel to conferences and meetings
- use gloves when handling products

<u>Our Product Supply</u> – Air-Tite normally holds (or has in transit) several months of inventory to avoid stockout situation from manufacturing/delivery delays or demand spikes. Currently, a very few SKUs have been significantly affected and are now out of stock. Air-Tite Products is working closely with our manufacturing and logistics partners, adjusting order quantities and release schedules, and requesting updates on the impacts of COVID-19.

We have confirmed through reputable health organizations that the virus would not remain viable on incoming product cartons through normal shipping methods (ocean shipments typically exceed 3 weeks, and air shipments exceed 1 week).

<u>Our Customers</u> – Air-Tite Products is committed to maintaining the high standards for service and supply that our customers expect. We are making every effort to:

- keep our products available at historically-consistent levels
- keep our staff healthy to avoid any supply interruptions
- keep our customers informed of this evolving situation
- help customers with potential alternatives in the event of supply delays
